What to Expect When Arriving!

PARKING

Valet services will not be available at this time; however limited self parking is available at hourly and daily rates. The surface lot entrance is the same entrance as the valet entrance, please see the parking map located on our website, www.pcoh.com under Directions to the Club.

ELEVATOR CAB CAPACITY LIMITS

Physical distancing markers are located on the floor of each elevator cab to indicate the maximum number of four occupants per cab.

FACE COVERINGS

Masks in the Club are not required for members, but for your safety, we encourage you to wear a face covering from your vehicle to the Club level.

What to Expect From Us!

CLEANING/SANITIZING

During closure, staff has been working hard to disinfect and clean all member areas. As we reopen, we will continue to enhance these sanitizing procedures and increase cleaning on specified high touch areas such as buttons, handles, etc.

EMPLOYEES

All kitchen and service employees will be required to wear face masks/coverings and gloves when in the Club. Upon entering the Club, employees will have their temperatures checked with our non-contact digital forehead thermometers.

We understand this is not our typical policy, however reservations will allow us to properly accommodate as many members as possible while still

SOCIAL DISTANCING TABLES

A maximum of 10 people will be permitted per table in the Noble Energy Grill and 6 people permitted per table in the Bayou Bengal Bar. In addition, tables must be 6 feet apart.

PRE-SET TABLES

Again, many of these restrictions are not up to our service standards, however we want to keep you safe and healthy. Tables will not be dressed with flatware or napkins, as we will be providing you with rolled silverware. Disposable items will also be provided including menus.

What to Expect From Other Members!
